REGISTRATION INFORMATION

For Registration you will need:

- ◆ A copy of birth certificate or other proof of age.
- ◆ Registration fee due in full at time of registration.
 - ◆ Visa and MasterCard accepted.
 - ◆ Checks or Money Orders Payable to CITY OF LOS ANGELES.
 - ◆ A collection fee will be charged for each returned check.
- ◆ Personal insurance needed, not provided by the CITY OF LOS ANGELES.

REFUND POLICY: You may request a refund before the programs scheduled first day. A 15% administration fee will be assessed for any patron granted a refund. Full refunds will not be issued unless a class or sports league is cancelled by the center. There will be NO REFUNDS after the program has begun unless a class or sports league is changed or cancelled by recreation center.

LEAGUE INFORMATION & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CARPOOL, SIBLINGS & REQUESTING A COACH: Carpool requests will not be accepted. Siblings will be placed on the same team unless otherwise requested. Players may not request a specific coach. Players are drafted and are not guaranteed to be placed on any specific team.

PRACTICES: At this time it is not known which days or times your child(ren) team will practice. Weekday practices are typically scheduled between 4:00 PM and 9:00 PM and Saturday between 8:00 am and 6:00 PM. Practice length varies between 1 to 2 hours once or twice a week.

There are no guarantees as to what time and day your child will practice each week. Refunds will not be issued if your child cannot make practices.

GAMES: The start of the season is tentatively scheduled for July 13, 2023. Teams will usually play one game during the week and one game on Saturday. Occasionally there may be 2 weekday games, no Saturday game or only a Saturday Game. Game times during the week are usually between 5:00 PM and 9:00 PM. Saturday game times are between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Game time will vary each week. At this time, game times and days have not been determined.

TRAVELING: In house league, No traveling required

UNIFORMS: Uniforms will be available for pick TBA.

MANDATORY PLAYING TIME:

In Mighty Mite division, each player must play 4 consecutive minutes per quarter.

In the Pee - Wee substitutions must be made at the 15, 10, and 5-minute mark of each half.

In the Minor, Major and Junior Divisions, substitutions must be made at the 15, 10, and 5-minute mark of the 1st half. Coaches must clear their benches. In the second half, coaches must clear their benches @ the 15 minute mark. The last 10 minutes are free substitutions.

AWARDS: Each player who completes the season will receive an award at the end of league play. An Awards Ceremony will be scheduled at the end of league play. THE RECREATION CENTER WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AWARDS NOT COLLECTED. Trophies/medals will be discarded by the 2025 Summer Season if not picked up from the Office

GENERAL INFORMATION: Your child's coach will be contacting you. If you do not receive a call by June 17, 2022 please call the recreation center. Please do not call the recreation center prior to that date regarding your child's practice. We would like to give your coach the opportunity to speak to you first.

Your coach will hold a parent meeting and give you all the information regarding your child's team and practice times. PLEASE REMEMBER all coaches are volunteers and without them your child would not be able to participate.
