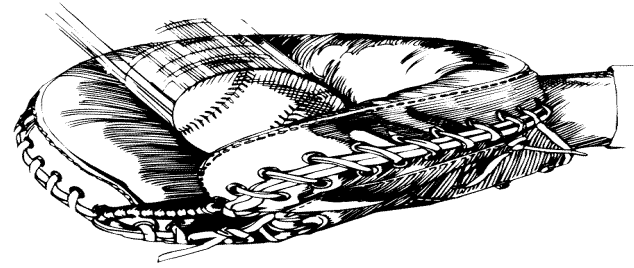

**Walk-in Registration** will take place in the Woodland Hills Park office starting Saturday, January 2, 2010 at 10:00 am. Registration will continue until all the divisions are full. Once a division is filled, a waiting list will be established and new participants will be selected from this list on the basis of an evaluation by a sports panel.

### REGISTRATION RULES:

2. You may register an immediate member of your family and one person only.
3. Requests for carpools will not be honored.
