REGISTRATION INFORMATION

MAIL-IN REGISTRATION

Mail postmarked prior to Monday August 31,2009 will be disregarded. Mail will be processed in the order received. We are not responsible for applications lost or delayed in the mail. **In accordance with the City Treasurer, writers of returned checks will be required to pay a collections fee of \$35.00 in addition to the face value of the check.**

REGISTER EARLY

Minimum enrollment is necessary to maintain each class. Unless the minimum is reached before the first class meeting, the class will be cancelled. Some classes fill rapidly and the maximum number may be reached before the final registration date. Participants must have reached the minimum age requirement by the first day of class. Proof of age may be required. **Due to the large number of applications received on the first day of registration, we can not guarantee that space will be available in all of your first choices.**

AFTER YOU ENROLL

You will receive a receipt approximately two weeks after you submit your application in the mail. If you are placed on a waiting list, a separate waiting list confirmation will be issued and your check will be returned to you. Please do not attend the first class. Should an opening arise, you will be contacted.

REFUND POLICY

If you wish to drop out of a class before 5:00 PM September 20, 2009, a \$15 administrative fee per participant will be deducted from your refund. There will be NO REFUNDS after September 20,2009 unless class is changed or cancelled by the recreation center. Refunds must be made in person.
