Cost to Play

League Fee (\$275.00) + #Forfeit Bond (\$344.00) + @Official's Fee \$50.00 per game = Total Due \$619.00

#Teams that already have a complete Forfeit Bond on file with the League will not be required to submit a new bond. Please note that at the conclusion of the league, Forfeit Bond shall remain in the Team's League File for usage in future leagues. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to request that their Forfeit Bond be refunded. Forfeit Bond will be forfeited if team is dormant from league for 3 consecutive years.

@Officials' Fee is to be paid in cash prior to start of game. Failure to comply will result in Forfeiture of game. Please note that \$50.00 fee is for 3 Officials. In the event that only 2 Officials are present, Officials' fee shall be \$42.00. In the event that only 1 Official is present, Official Fee shall be \$27.00.

Other Information

- Registration for League will be accepted starting November 3, 2008 and will continue until leagues fills or 5:00pm on December 12, 2008.
- League will start the week of January 11, 2009. Space is limited. Sign up early!
- Up to two pre season practice games may be scheduled for teams who wish to play practice games and for new teams who are not sure as to which division they should register for.
- All players will need to sign the Roster that bears the Release of Liability Waiver before participating in the league. Roster must be turned in before the start of the season. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of the game(s).
Note: Players who miss signing the Team Roster will need to sign the Player Registration Form.
- All players will need to turn in their valid League ID Card at the start of each game.
- Team Managers are responsible to assure that players who participate in the game have signed the roster and are eligible.
- League maintains a ZERO tolerance for fighting. Any individual who engages in a physical altercation will be suspended from the remainder of the league. This applies to both instigator and retaliator.
- All forms discussed in this application can be obtained from the League's Web Site.
- It is the responsibility of each Team Manager to know the League Rules and to inform all members of their team.

Forfeit Bond

- Full Bond must be paid in full before team will be allowed to start.
- Bond is refundable at end of league play upon written request from the individual who paid the bond.
- All or part of the bond may be forfeited for any of the Following reasons:
 - A) Dropping out of the League.
 - B) Unsportsmanlike conduct, Fighting, intoxication, use of obscene language.
 - C) Failure on the part of any player or manager to abide by Official's decision.
 - D) Failure of team to be active for a three-year period.
 - E) Playing of any ineligible player.

- Minimum balance allowed for bond is \$176.00. Teams will be dropped from league if bond is not replenished.

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MUNICIPAL SPORTS – REFUND POLICY AND PARTICIPANT’S CODE OF CONDUCT

Refund Policy: No refunds after 5:00p.m., on Friday, December 19, 2008.

The primary purpose of adult sports programs is to offer each resident of our city the opportunity to pursue, through competitive sports, the physical and emotional benefits such activity offers.

All too often the emphasis in such participation has been placed on winning at any cost.

It should be remembered that in every competitive sports activity there are winners and losers. The purpose of this Code of Conduct, applicable to every participant, is to engender and motivate a return to good sportsmanship, proper conduct on and off the field, and fully complying with the rules and policies of the Los Angeles Municipal Sports section. Every individual and team participating has adequate recourse through established procedures in the filing of complaints or protest.

Effective immediately, the Code of Conduct, as defined below, is in force. Team managers will carefully review the rules and requirements herewith set forth and to make them known to their players. They are solely responsible for actions of their teams and players on and off the field. Improper behavior on the part of any participant can directly affect the future participation by the entire team. Be reminded that all team members including Coaches are not to: consume alcoholic beverages or smoke at or around game facilities, nor shall they dress or urinate in public. Penalty: Immediate suspension and loss of league fees.

Code of Conduct

The Participant’s Code of Conduct applies to all players, coaches, and managers. This code applies to players as individuals or as a team, and the penalties can be applied to any individual or an entire team. This code becomes effective as soon as the participants arrive at the facility of play and remains in effect until the participants leave the facility.

- A. No Participant shall:
 1. At any time lay hand upon, push, shove, strike or threaten to strike an official.
 2. Be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor upon any player, official or spectator.
 3. Endanger the safety of any player, official or spectator.
- B. No Participant shall:
 1. Refuse to abide by an official’s decision.
 2. Be guilty of heaping personal, verbal abuse upon any official for any real or imaginary wrong decision or judgment.
 3. Be guilty of using unnecessary rough tactics in the play of the game against an opposing player.
- C. No Participant shall:
 1. Be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at an official’s decision by throwing equipment or any other forceful action.
 2. Discuss with an official in any manner the decision reached by such official (except Manager).
- D. No Participant shall:
 1. Smoke while going on or coming off the facility, or while on the field of play.
 2. Be guilty of discussing publicly with spectators in a derogatory manner any play, decision, or personal opinion of other players during the game. (No trash talk!)
 3. Appear on/at the facility at any time in an intoxicated condition, or consume any alcoholic beverage while on a recreation facility.
- E. All players must sign the game score sheet, all players will need to turn in their valid League ID Card at the start of each game.
- F. All players must sign Official Team Roster or Player Registration Form prior to participation or be subject to game forfeiture or disqualification.
- G. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to obtain and understand the League Rules. Additionally, it is also the Manager’s responsibility to make certain that his team members understand the rules.

NOTE: We are mandating that officials report any participant that is difficult or that refuses to abide by our league’s motto of friendly competition – no profanity. We are committed in making our leagues the best they can be. Particular attention will be made to player conduct and excessive contact.

I have discussed the Refund Policy and this Code of Conduct with my team and we understand the above rules and policies. I also understand that it is my responsibility to understand and convey the League Rules to my entire team.
