Spring Sports Information

Registration is currently on going for the following sports: Baseball, Soccer and Volleyball.

Baseball—Ages 5-10-Divisions Offered are T-Ball, 5 Pitch and Minors. Fee is \$120 per child. Evaluation day will be on Tuesday, March 7th, with the season beginning April 1st.

Soccer-Ages 5-15— Divisions Offered are: Lil Dribblers, Jr. Jugglers, Big Kickers, and Sweepers. Girls divisions are offered for all divisions but sweepers. Fee is \$140 per child. Evaluation day is Feb 25th with games beginning March 25th.

Girls Volleyball - Ages 9-12, Divisions Offered, Minors and Majors. Fee is \$70 per child. Evaluation day is on Saturdays March 18th with games beginning in first part of April.

Mar Vista Pre-Kinder Program

This program emphasizes independence, social interaction, and following directions in a group setting and fun filled environment. Activities include: outdoor play, arts & crafts, field trips . Students are to bring a lunch each day. All children are to be completely potty trained,
