





AGE/GRADE: Grade will be determined as of Fall 2024. Children will be grouped according to grade level. There are NO requests.

**AUTHORIZED PICK UP ADDITIONS**: Any additions to the Authorized Pick Up list can be made via email or in person at our office. Emails must include the legal name (as it appears on the driver's license) of the person picking up your child. Emails must also be sent from the email on your child's registration form and must state the camper's name and birthday. Additions made in person may only be made by a parent/guardian and may require photo identification. We do not accept over the phone additions.

**PAYMENTS**: Balance due TWO MONDAYS (Camp Sharwood & Woodies) prior to the week attending camp, with the exception of the first week attending, which will be due at registration. All payments must be made in full on or before the due date. Failure to pay on or before the due date will result in losing your child's spot in camp. Payments can be made via our RecTrac system (online). Payments cannot be made over the phone. Scholarships available please contact Recreation Center Office.

**REFUNDS**: There are NO refunds after payment due date for that week this includes field trips. There are no refunds, transfers, or makeups of missed days. No exceptions. Please be sure to check your child's school calendar for the summer break dates. This is your responsibility. The number of children registered in our program determines our staffing, supplies, materials, field trip reservations and buses reserved. A 15% administration fee will be assessed for any patron granted a refund by the Accounting Sept. An additional \$35 applied by the center, should a refund be granted.

**REGISTRATION**: A one time \$35 registration fee due when registering. The registration fee is NON- REFUNDABLE.

**DEPOSITS**: A \$40 deposit is required for each week/session. All deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE. Deposits are deducted from the weekly/session fee at the time payment is due. Payment due dates for each camp vary, check the payment schedule. Failure to pay your balance by the due date may result in loss of space & deposit or a \$25 late fee, if spaces remain.

**SIGN-IN & OUT**: Parents or authorized persons must sign camper(s) in and out each day. Campers may NOT sign themselves in or out without prior written parent approval. Photo ID is required to pick up any camper. Please note: different counselors may do sign-out daily and all counselors are instructed to ask for ID. Include all persons who will be allowed to pick up your child on the registration form. Written permission and identification (of parent) must be (emailed) provided if you wish your child to be released to anyone other than those authorized on the registration form after the start of camp.

# WHRC GENERAL CAMP POLICIES

**DISCIPLINE POLICY:** Our programs advocate a positive guidance and discipline policy with an emphasis on positive reinforcement, redirection, prevention, and the development of self-discipline. Campers will receive verbal misbehavior warnings. If misbehavior continues, suspension, expulsion, or discharge may result without a refund. Please see "Safety" for additional information.

**SAFETY:** There is a zero tolerance policy in regards to the safety of each camper. Fighting of any kind including pushing, shoving, hitting, biting, scratching, verbal abuse, harassment or bullying, profanity, immoral conduct, inappropriate touching, degrading remarks not be tolerated. Lack of following rules or instructions given by staff will not be tolerated. Stealing or vandalism will not be tolerated. Possessing weapons or illegal substances will result in further legal action and dismissal from camp. Woodland Hills Rec. Center reserves the right to suspend, expel, or discharge a camper for misbehavior **without** a refund.

**EMERGENCIES**: Woodland Hills Recreation Center staff is mandated to report any suspected form of child abuse to the proper authorities. In case of emergencies - earthquakes, fires, etc., all children will remain on the premises and released only to those authorized on their Emergency Form, with I.D's. In case of community emergencies, we will work directly with L.A.P.D and our Recreation Supervisors for updates, instructions, and procedures we are to follow.

**BEVERAGES**: Punch and water will be served during the camp day. Camp punch is typically lemonade, pink lemonade, orange drink, or sweet tea. Juice or soda may be available for field trips (Camp Sharwood & Woodies) but this will be noted in the weekly newsletter.

**EXTENDED DAY CARE**: (Camp Sharwood & Woodies only) Extended Day Care (EDC) is available from 8:00am-9:30am and 4:00pm-6:00pm. Camp activities run from 9:30am-4:00pm. A.M. EDC will be held in the gym and P.M. EDC will be held in the Activity Room. See "Late Pick Up" for more information.

**FIELD TRIPS**: (Camp Sharwood & Woodies) Field trips are taken on Thursdays. There are no alternative camp activities provided if the camper is not enrolled for the field trip. Field Trips vary on arrival time, please be sure to check our weekly newsletter for more information. Any field trips that were missed or arrived after departure will not be granted a refund as tickets are purchased in advance. We will do our best to adhere to the departure and arrival time posted for each trip. Parents are not allowed to drop off campers at field trip sites if bus is missed. Due to unforeseen circumstances, traffic, inclement weather, and/or mechanical problems, the buses may be delayed.

**FINAL SHOW**: Camp Sharwood Final Show is the culmination of our wonderful summer experiences. All campers participate in song and dance and a theatrical production. Families all join together for a fun-filled evening at Woodland Hills Rec. Center. Be sure to join us for Week 8, the show will be the evening of **Friday, August 4, 2023.** Everyone is welcome!

**FIRST AID**: Most minor injuries can be taken care of with band-aid first aid. No medicine of any kind can be used without the parent signing it in to the office with a medical release form. All staff are trained in First Aid/CPR. Staff will report all injuries, verbally or in writing, to parents. Any injuries of the neck and above will be reported immediately to parent/guardians via phone call.

**KONA ICE FRIDAYS & MONEY**: The Kona Ice truck or cart comes to Camp Sharwood on select Fridays throughout the summer during PM snack time. Money must be sent in a labeled bag or envelope. Money may be held in the office. WHRC and Camp Sharwood are not responsible for any lost or stolen money.

**LATE PICK UP**: Campers who are not picked up at 4:00pm will be taken to the EDC Room for pick up. Campers who are picked up after 6:00pm will be brought to the office and parents will be charged a late pick-up fee of \$10. If parent/guardian is late more than 3 times they will be charged \$1.00 per minute in addition to the \$10.00 fee. See "Extended Day Care" for more information.

MAKE-UP DAYS: There are NO "MAKE-UP" days for time missed at camp.

**MEDICAL INFORMATION**: If any medication (topical cream/ointment, sunscreen, ibuprofen, chapstick) is required, please request a medical form from the office. Completed medical forms w/ a photo ID of the child must be brought to the office w/ the meds.

**DRESS CODE**: For safety purposes, camp t-shirts, closed toed, and closed heeled shoes must be worn daily. No exceptions. Shoes must be closed toed to allow campers to play safely. Any child that attends camp without an appropriate camp t-shirt will be issued one and you will be billed accordingly. See "T-Shirts" for more information.

# WHRC GENERAL CAMP POLICIES

**MOVIES**: All movies shown at/or during camp will either be rated G or PG.

**PARENT & GUARDIAN CONDUCT**: All patrons are expected to be courteous to camp counselors, WHRC staff, camp directors and all patrons of the park and its programs.

**PARKING**: For the safety of all the children there is NO CURB/PARKING LOT DROP OFF, STOPPING OR PARKING in the red zones, staff parking or parking in handicap spots without placard displayed.

**PHOTOGRAPHS**: By enrolling your camper(s) in the camp program, you agree to allow the City of Los Angeles Dept. of Recreation and Parks and the Woodland Hills Recreation Center/Camp programs to use photographs, videos, and testimonials of participants for use in publicity material free of any fee or usage charge unless otherwise notified.

**PERSONAL ITEMS**: Camper(s) are not permitted to bring personal items to camp. If brought these items must be kept in backpacks, if not, they may be held in the office to be picked up by a parent/guardian. City of Los Angeles Dept. of Rec. & Parks and WHRC will not be held responsible for personal items brought to camp, this includes lost or stolen items. Such items include: toys, games, game/trading cards, CELL PHONES, IPads, "smart" watches, IPods, handheld games, etc.

**REGISTRATION FORM**: Registration forms must be filled out and submitted before the first day of camp. Registration form ensures the safety of your child as it contains emergency contact information and understanding of rules and regulations.

**SHADOWS/AIDES**: For shadows or aides present during camp hours a parent will need to send camp an email (Rap.campsharwood@lacity.org) to gather further information on getting an aide processed. Shadows or aides attending field trips shall require a field trip fee. We strongly recommend to gather information needed as soon as possible.

**SICK CHILDREN**: Please do not send your child if they are sick or do not feel well enough to participate comfortably in the program's activities. Children who are sent home with a fever, vomiting, or COVID symptoms will not be permitted back in camp for 24 hours.

**SPIRIT DAYS**: Campers are highly encouraged to participate in Spirit Day dress up! Campers who dress up are to bring a camp shirt in their backpack in case they would like to change. Campers participating in spirit dress up will be given a wristband for ID and safety purposes. All dress-up costumes must be appropriate and may not have any props that are weapons or masks, etc.

SPLIT PAYMENT: Parent/Guardian will be held responsible for determining payment between families who do not share a household.

SUBJECT TO CHANGE: All camp policies, field trips, themes, events, dates, etc. are subject to change.

**SUNSCREEN**: Sunscreen is highly recommended daily. Please apply before camp and send some with your camper(s) each day. If your child cannot apply sunscreen without assistance, the sunscreen must be marked as medication and be brought to the office.

**SWIM**: (Camp Sharwood & Woodies) Due to the aquatics department rules and regulations, children ages 7 years and under are not permitted in the large pool area without a one-to-one ratio, which we do our best to provide. Children are not required to enter the swimming pool. We will have alternative "cool-down" activities or indoor activities for children who choose not to swim. Camp Sharwood swim times will be posted in the weekly newsletter and are subject to change.
