A part of the job will be reporting job orders, field maintenance issues and cleaning and prepping the field's restroom attending. Answering phones, accepting applications, Xeroxing and other duties as required. **Minimum Requirements:** 18 yrs. or older, reliable, dependable willing to work nights and weekends. Ability to lift 10-15 pounds.
