DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT:			
On June 2, 2022, the Board of Recreation and Parks Commissioners (Board) approved the original scope of work for the Project (Report No. 22-140) which included: ADA-compliant path of travel improvements; landscaping and irrigation improvements; installation of solar panels on the roof of the recreation center building; installation of new LED lighting at sports fields and courts, and related electrical infrastructure upgrades; installation of new security cameras; resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts; construction of a self-cleaning restroom adjacent to the East edge of the football stadium; replacement of artificial turf and the rubberized track in the stadium; construction of artificial turf and a fence in the area known as Baseball Diamond No. 3; painting and repair of the existing Tennis Pro Shop, stadium entry, and concession shop walls eaves and facia.			
RAP Board exempted the project from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A Notice of Exemption (NOE) was filed with the Los Angeles County Clerk on July 22, 2022.			
RAP has reevaluated the scope of work for this Project and has determined it is more efficient to split it up into two (2) separate phases. Certain elements of the Project currently in-progress will be completed in this current phase, and the other items will be completed under a separate phase.			
The revised scope of the Project which are to be completed as part of this current phase includes: ADA-compliant path of travel improvements; landscaping and irrigation improvements; installation of new LED lighting at sports fields and courts, and related electrical infrastructure upgrades; installation of new security cameras; resurfacing of the tennis courts.			
The revised scope of the Project is a reduction from the project scope previously approved by the Board under Report No. 22-140, but staff is recommending a \$ 1,053,574.06 increase in funding for this Project. This is because the bids RAP received for the original proposed scope of work under Report No. 22-140 came back substantially higher than originally anticipated. Therefore, despite the reduction in scope items, additional funding is necessary to complete the scope of work for this phase. Beneficiaries of the project are the patrons of the park.
