



TREES IN TRIBUTE

The Trees in Tribute program makes it possible for members of the community to recognize and honor special people with a lasting living gift, while helping to fulfill the City's continuous need for trees in our parks. All trees planted will be counted towards the City's tree planting initiatives.

A tree planted in a local park can become a lasting memorial to someone whose life should be remembered, or a way of commemorating a special event such as a birthday, retirement, graduation, birth of a baby, religious occasion, or just in celebration of a unique and wonderful life.

The trees will be planted and maintained by the Department of Recreation and Parks. Large 15-gallon trees will be planted in locations suited for their long term survival. If you have a preference, a tree will be planted in a park of your choice, provided that adequate space is available.

The recipient or donor of the tribute tree will receive a letter of notification and a certificate. A permanent record will be kept on file that will include the name of the person or persons being honored, the variety of tree, and the location of the tree planted in their honor. Your tax deductible donation will include purchase of the tree, staking, mulch, and maintenance.

The cost to dedicate one tree is \$250.00
