**DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES**: Applicants will teach classes or assist with sports programs for participants, ages 3-17 years. Applicants must have leadership skills, be organized, and be able to interact with the public in a positive and professional manner. Applicants will be selected based on knowledge of the class or sport they are teaching/helping with and must be able to explain and demonstrate methods they would use to plan and implement the class/sport.
