BOXING INSTRUCTOR

Available Hours: Up to 20/week, preferred availability Monday-Friday 9:00am-12:00pm and 3:00pm-9:00pm
(Hours may vary depending on the needs of the program.)

Job Description

Instructor will be supervising a group of 10 children per class and teaching basic boxing techniques, positions of feet, warm-up techniques, conditioning exercises and more. Students should learn in a fun environment with a structured program. Students should visibly move through levels so that progress can be seen.

Responsibilities:

1. Knowledge and ability to teach children ages 5-17 and adults 18+.
2. Instruct boxing participants on safe boxing techniques and physical training regimens
3. Create and implement a structured program.
4. Set-up, break-down, and cleaning/sanitizing of equipment to be used for activities.
5. Maintain knowledge of proper equipment and ability to set up boxing equipment
6. Ability to maintain cooperative working relationships with City staff, volunteers, public groups, media and others contacted in the course of work
7. Be available to teach class at designated time/ day.
8. Greet and verify participants' weekly negative Covid-19 test and temperature checks prior to each class.
9. Knowledge of City policies, rules and regulations governing the conduct and safety of using recreational facilities, programs and equipment
10. Follow and implement COVID-19 protocols and procedures such as wearing a mask, social distancing, etc.

Qualifications:

- Must 18 years or older
- Prior experience working with a group of children, ages 5-17 years old and adults 18+ preferred.
- Physically able to participate in fitness activities, including walking, kneeling, standing for long periods at a time crouch, squat, twist, stoop and climb, and be able to carry at least 50 lbs.
- Two (2) years of progressive experience participating or coaching in a boxing program desired.
- Possession of valid Membership and USA Boxing Coach Certificate preferred.
- CPR and First Aid certification preferred.
- Ability to speak Spanish is highly desirable.
- Self-driven, professional, possess good work ethic, and ability to be punctual and reliable.
- Excellent and effective communication skills with teens, children, staff and patrons.
- Candidates with availability to work all assigned shifts, which may include mornings, afternoons, evening shifts, and/or occasional weekends preferred.
