Activity Leaders spend the majority of their time working and running the high ropes course/climbing wall but will also lead games and assist with many different activities as needed.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

- Work on/run high ropes course and climbing wall.
- Maintain equipment, sanitize equipment, inspect equipment.
- Supervise and lead children through activities.
- Responsible for the general wellbeing of campers.
- Identify and meet campers needs.
- Carry out and follow camp programs.
- Provide a safe, friendly, encouraging environment to campers and co-workers.
- Create, plan and lead a variety of activities.
- Follow and adhere to all COVID protocols which includes but are not limited to wearing a mask, cleaning equipment, staying within a specific pod, washing hands regularly, etc.
- Available weekly summer sessions. (Counselors may request 1 week off during the summer.) Dates may vary depending on COVID protocols.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age;
- Must have High School Diploma or equivalent and preferably 1 year of college;
- Ability to complete High Ropes Course training;
- Ability to work at heights up to 50 feet for extended periods of time;
- Ability to lift 50 pounds;
- Experience working with children is desired but not mandatory;
- Ability to identify and put campers needs first;
- Ability to teach a variety of activities;
- Possess an enthusiastic and positive outlook;
- Possess excellent communication skills and the ability to speak and perform in front of large groups;
- Ability to communicate and work with a variety of ages and skill levels plus the desire to make a positive difference in a child's life;
- Present a neat and professional appearance as well as possess good character, integrity, judgment and adaptability;
- Possess critical thinking skills and techniques to be applied to situations that may arise with campers;
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance.
