Assistant Park Services Attendants are part-time, at-will employees of the City of Los Angeles, Department of Recreation & Parks limited to 1040 hours per year.

Park Services Office operates the Griffith Pay Parking/Greek Theatre Traffic Control program. The Traffic Control program assists and works with Park Rangers and Observatory Traffic staff. The goal is to assist park patrons with pay machines and also assist on where to park and how to get to different areas of Griffith Park on Greek Theatre show nights and extremely crowded and high traffic days or weekends.

**Available Hours:**

- 10 – 20 hours per week, based on schedule and shift availability.
- Hours and reporting location will be Griffith Park Nursery.
- **Must be available to work evenings, weekends and holidays.**
- Ability to lift 10-25 Lbs.
- Able to stand for long periods of time.
- Ability to work outdoors in hot & cold weather conditions.
