## TEMPORARY CLOSURES IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

LA City Department of Recreation and Parks is reopening some amenities in accordance with guidance from health officials while other areas remain temporarily closed to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

**NO GROUP GATHERINGS ALLOWED. SOCIAL DISTANCING & FACE COVERINGS REQUIRED.**

## OPEN

Social distancing & face coverings required

Outdoor areas at:

- Parks will remain open during regular park hours for the purpose of walking, running or jogging.
- Outdoor public bathrooms will remain open during regular operating hours.
- Lakes for fishing (Fishing at Cabrillo Beach and Venice Beach Pier not permitted)
- Dog parks

## LIMITED

Social distancing, face coverings & specific guidelines required

These facilities and areas will have limited access effective May 15:

- Tennis and pickleball courts (singles play only)
- Equestrian centers
- Golf courses. All pro shops and indoor dining are to remain closed except for take-out food purchases or paying for golf services.
- All public trails and trailhead parks, except for Runyon Canyon.

## CLOSED

- All play and sports amenities closed until further notice, including but not limited to playgrounds, fitness equipment areas, skate parks, basketball/volleyball courts, baseball/soccer/multiuse fields, and lawn bowling.
- Buildings and indoor facilities closed to public: Restrooms, gymnasiums, aquatics centers, senior and community centers, multi-purpose rooms/classrooms
- Public beach parking lots and piers in the City of Los Angeles are closed.

We will continue to assess daily our operations and consult with Public Health for recommendations and possible further changes. We will keep you informed of any necessary changes to our programs.
