SOCIAL DISTANCING & FACE COVERINGS REQUIRED.**

OPEN Social distancing & face coverings required

- Parks open during regular park hours for the purpose of walking, running or jogging.
- Outdoor public bathrooms open during regular operating hours.
- Lakes for fishing (Fishing at Cabrillo Beach and Venice Beach Pier not permitted)
- Equestrian centers
- Dog parks
- Golf courses

LIMITED Social distancing, face coverings & specific guidelines required

- Public trails and trailhead parks. Runyon Canyon open temporarily. Wisdom Tree trail closed until further notice.
- Tennis and pickleball courts (singles play only)
- Venice and Cabrillo Beach open for active recreation only (running, walking, swimming & surfing)
- Venice and Cabrillo Beach parking lots open with limited capacity.
- Venice Beach Boardwalk/Ocean Front Walk remains closed— with limited access to businesses for curbside pick-up only.

CLOSED

- All play and sports amenities closed until further notice, including but not limited to playgrounds, fitness equipment areas, skate parks, basketball/volleyball courts, baseball/soccer/multiuse fields, and lawn bowling.
- Buildings and indoor facilities closed to public: restrooms, gymnasiums, aquatics centers, senior and community centers, multi-purpose rooms/classrooms
- Beach piers in the City of Los Angeles remain closed.

We will continue to assess daily our operations and consult with Public Health for recommendations and possible further changes. We will keep you informed of any necessary changes to our programs.
