RECOMMENDATIONS

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- Approve the scope of work and the total budget of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Park Synthetic Field Renovation (PRJ21755) Project (Project), as described in the Summary of this Report;
- 2. Authorize Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) staff to commit from the following fund and work order numbers listed in Attachment 1, a maximum of Three Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$378,961.85) in Park Fees for the proposed Project;
- 3. Approve the Project to be bid and constructed through the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) list of pre-qualified on-call contractors;
- 4. Approve the authorization of change orders as authorized under Board Report No. 06-136, for the construction contracts for this Project in the budget contingency amounts for such contracts as stated in this Report;
- 5. Determine that the Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article 19, Section 15302 [replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose

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and capacity as the structure replaced] California CEQA Guidelines and Article III, Section 1, Class 2 of City CEQA Guidelines, and direct RAP staff to file a Notice of Exemption (NOE) with the Los Angeles County Clerk;

- 6. Authorize RAP's Chief Accounting Employee to prepare a check to the Los Angeles County Clerk in the amount of \$75.00 for the purpose of filing an NOE; and,
- 7. Authorize RAP staff to make technical corrections as necessary to carry out the intent of this Report.

SUMMARY

Martin Luther King, Jr. Park is located at 3916 South Western Avenue in the South Los Angeles area of the City. This 8.33-acre facility provides a baseball diamond, basketball courts, children's play area, picnic tables, tennis courts and a recreation center for the surrounding community. Approximately 6,857 City residents live within a one-half mile walking distance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Park. Due to the size of the park, and the facilities, features, and services it provides, Martin Luther King, Jr. Park meets the standard for a Community Park, as defined in the City's Public Recreation Plan.

PROJECT SCOPE

The scope of work of the proposed Project includes the following:

- Demolish the existing field. The contractor must ensure no damage to the existing base with no driving on the base without turf under equipment tires. Field must be repurposed with no disposal in landfill.
- Regrade area to ensure the existing base meets specifications requirements.
- Adjust nail board to ensure room for new pad system underlying turf.
- Provide All-Weather turf system per specifications.
- Provide layout to match existing soccer layout.
- Adjust any existing boxes and sports equipment to match new grade of pad and turf.
- Adjust existing nailer board to accept new pad underlying the turf system.

PROJECT FUNDING

Upon approval of this Report, Three Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$378,961.85) in Park Fees can be committed to the proposed Project, which is the total budget including the budget contingency amount set forth below.

See below the anticipated pre-qualified on-call contract(s) and budget contingency amount(s) that will be used for the Project:

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The Park Fees were collected within five (5) miles of Martin Luther King, Jr. Park, which is the standard distance for the commitment of Park Fees for community recreational facilities pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.33 E.3.

TREES AND SHADE

The proposed Project will have no impact on the existing trees and shade at Martin Luther King, Jr. Park.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The proposed Project consists of the demolition and replacement of an existing field with a new field at an existing institutional facility.

According to the parcel profile report retrieved on January 2, 2024, the construction of this Project is not in a liquefaction zone and the construction of this Project will not create conditions that could expose patrons of the park to increased risk of liquefaction. This site is not within a coastal or methane zone, so there is no reasonable possibility that the proposed Project may impact an environmental resource of hazardous or critical concern or have a significant effect due to unusual circumstances. No other known projects would involve cumulatively significant impacts, and no future projects would result from the proposed Project. As of January 2, 2024, the State Department of Toxic Substances Control (CTSC) (Envirostor at www.envirostor.dtsc.ca.gov) and Water Control Board (SWCB) (Geotracker the State Resources www.geotracker.waterboards.ca.gov) have listed Case T10000005395 within 1,000 feet of the Project area. The case was of a leaking underground storage tank and has been closed after remediation on June 7, 1994. It is not listed in the hazardous materials release sites, pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5. According to the Caltrans Scenic Highway Map there is no

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scenic highway located within the vicinity of the proposed Project or within its site. The proposed Project is not in an area that would affect a historic or cultural monument.

Based on this information, RAP staff recommends that the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners' (Board) determines that the proposed Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article 19, Section 15302 of California CEQA Guidelines and Article III, Section 1, Class 2 of City CEQA Guidelines. Staff will file a Notice of Exemption with the Los Angeles County Clerk upon the Board's approval.

FISCAL IMPACT

The approval of this commitment of Park Fees will have no fiscal impact on RAP's General Fund. The estimated costs for the design, development, and construction of the proposed park improvements are anticipated to be funded by Park Fees, or funding sources other than RAP's General Fund. Future staffing and equipment cost demands for the new improvements will be requested through RAP's new and expanded budget process.
