SUMMARY

RAP anticipates additional appropriations are needed for the following accounts in the following amount: Salaries, As-Needed (\$9,500,000.00) and Operating Supplies, (\$1,500,000.00).

A transfer to Salaries, As-Needed is needed to reimburse and reconcile costs incurred by RAP to support Summer Night Lights (SNL) programming for the last two fiscal years, preparing for upcoming seasonal programming (e.g., Aquatics, Summer Camp) and to react promptly to unforeseen events (e.g., extreme weather, arrival of asylum seekers). Due to unfilled full-time positions, there was a higher than usual need for As-Needed staffing.

A transfer to Operating Supplies is needed to procure various supplies for the upcoming summer season including food for SNL, summer camp T-shirts, etc.

FISCAL IMPACT

The transfers between accounts within Fund 302 are for budgetary adjustments that have a net zero impact on RAP's General Fund.
