QUESTIONS & ANSWERS No. 2

Note: In an effort to provide timely response, there will be additional response(s) to the remaining questions received.

1. Question: In regards to meeting minimum qualifications, if an officer of the proposing corporate entity individually possesses the minimum experience necessary as cited in the RFP, but the corporate entity itself does not meet the threshold of minimum experience in its own contract history, will the proposing corporate entity be deemed as meeting the minimum qualifications?

Answer: Yes, the individual experience of an officer of the proposing entity may be used to meet the minimum experience for the corporate entity.

2. Question: In regards to meeting minimum qualifications, if the proposer is a joint venture between two entities and only one of the two possesses the minimum experience necessary as cited in the RFP, will the joint venture be deemed as meeting the minimum qualifications?

Answer: Yes, the individual experience of one entity of the joint venture may be used to meet the minimum experience for the joint venture.

3. Question: Is a letter of guarantee from a financial institution, addressed to an individual, and not the proposing company, but said individual is the sole owner of the proposing company, acceptable?

Answer: Yes.
