You're invited!

Our Fall Family Outings are open to families, couples, individuals, small groups of friends, or anyone else interested in spending quality time in nature! Check-in begins Saturday at 10:00 a.m. and the program concludes on Sunday after lunch around 1:00 p.m. The program is designed for participants of all ages to engage in a variety of activities and to encourage meeting new friends. It's your camping experience, so we welcome you to do as much or as little as you want. Children must be supervised at all times while at camp. You must bring your own bedding and any personal items you may need. You must provide your own transportation to and from Camp Seely. Please note, there is no wi-fi and limited (if any) cell service on-site, so please plan accordingly.

Camp Seely

Camp Seely is located in Crestline, CA, nestled in the San Bernardino Mountains at an elevation of 4,200 feet. A little over 60 miles from Los Angeles, the facility includes cozy cabins, indoor and outdoor picnic tables for family dining, restrooms, shower facilities, a playing field, a sand volleyball court, ping pong tables, a basketball court and a children's playground!

Camp Fees

The experience costs \$65 per person. Participants under 3 years old are free. Fees include the scheduled program activities, one night's lodging in a single-family heated cabin, and four meals served in the rustic dining hall.

Registration

Registration is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Cabins are assigned upon arrival, and sleep 4-5 people. There is a maximum of 5 people in a cabin. If there are more than 5 people, the family will be split up into 2 or more cabins next to each other. There must be at least one adult in each cabin. Space is limited. Camp registration/waiver forms and fees are to be completed and paid online. Please visit us at www.laparks.org/camp/camp-seely to sign-up.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be submitted in writing at least two weeks prior to the outing in order to receive a refund. Refunds can take up to six weeks to process. There will be a \$25 administration fee, per person, deducted from your refund. There are no refunds for cancellations made within two weeks of the outing.

General Policies

There is to be no smoking, vaping, alcohol or drug use on site. Pets must stay at home. The following misconduct will not be tolerated: fighting, refusal to obey the rules or directions of the staff, theft and/or property damage. Failure to adhere to these policies may result in removal from the facility. There are no refunds for misconduct.

If you are a person with a disability and require accommodation to participate in a City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks program, service, or activity, requests may be made by calling the facility (323-467-7193), or 711 for CA Relay, ten days in advance of the event. We will do our best to fulfill requests with less than ten business days' notice.
