Dear Friends,

Thank you for taking the time to explore the opportunities of Camp Seely's Family Outings. We are very proud of the program we provide, and welcome the opportunity to better acquaint you with our out-of-town facility.

We have been providing family outings since 1973. The Family Outings are open to people of all ages, single individuals, couples or families, and small groups of families or friends. Please limit your group to 20 people total (approximately 4 to 5 families).

The program is designed for participation from all ages, in activities that relate to nature, to the environment, and encourage the meeting of new friends. It's your camping experience, so we welcome you to do as much, or as little as you like.

Our overnight experience is to provide your family with the opportunity to enjoy the beauty of the area, and a variety of camping activities. There are morning, afternoon and evening hikes, fun lodge games, marshmallow roasting, crafts and other activities.

The facility includes 64 cabins, a large kitchen and dining hall, rustic lodge, restrooms and shower facilities, a playing field, sand volleyball court, basketball court and children's play area.

Camp Staff and Rangers are available for any questions regarding the program.

Camp Seely is located in the San Bernardino Mountains, 65 miles from Los Angeles City Hall, nestled at an elevation of 4,200 ft. Camp Seely is near Lake Gregory and the town of Crestline on Highway 138, four miles east of the Lake Silverwood State Recreation Area.

Camping Fees:

- \$65 per person (regardless of age)
 - Fees include the scheduled program of activities, *one* night's lodging in a single family heated cabin, and *four* (4) meals served buffet style in the dining hall.
- *August outing \$110 per person (regardless of age)
 - Fees include the scheduled program of activities, *two* night's lodging in a single family heated cabin, and *six* (6) meals served buffet style in the dining hall.

You must provide your own transportation to and from camp, your own bedding, and any personal items you may need. Registration and cabin assignments begin at 10 a.m. on Saturday. The outing ends after lunch on Sunday at 1 p.m.

*August outing registration and cabin assignments begin at 5 p.m. on Friday night. The outing ends after lunch on Sunday at 1 p.m.

Reservations are required in advance and space is limited. Registration is accepted by mail only, and taken on a first-come, first-serve basis. Payment by check or money order only. A collection fee will be charged for each check returned by the bank.

Cancellation of Reservation

- With notice of more two weeks prior to outing date, a full refund, minus a \$25 administrative fee.
- With notice of less than two weeks prior to outing date, no refund.

Change to Reservation

- Changes in group size are only allowed if space is available.
 - With notice of more than two weeks prior to outing date, there will be no administrative fee.
 - With notice of less than two weeks prior to outing date, there will be a \$25 administrative fee per change.

Persons with disabilities are welcome to participate in our programs. Reasonable accommodations will be made with prior arrangements.

The programs in this brochure may be subject to cancellation or change.
