## Kamp Kaleidoscope CIT (Counselor In Training)

We are looking for responsible, outgoing, and enthusiastic CIT's who are ready to dedicate their summer to working with children.

### Our CIT Program

The Counselor in Training program was designed to enrich the lives of the youth in our community by providing an enjoyable training experience. CITs in our program will find the experience personally rewarding as well as broaden their social experience. Participation in camp will provide CITs with a valuable learning experience that can be utilized in future job interests. A CITs typical work day runs Monday-Friday from 8:30am-4:30pm, unless they are assigned additional hours for extended care and/or field trip days.

### Position Requirements

To be considered for the position applicants must; be 13 years of age by the first day of camp, commit to a minimum of 4 full camp weeks Monday-Friday between the hours of 7:30am-6:00pm, available to attend all training days and get finger printed prior to camp. Candidates must know how to swim and may be required to swim daily. Candidates must have the ability to relate and supervise children 3-12 years of age and must possess the ability to take directions and accept responsibilities. CITs must demonstrate a more mature level of understanding than campers. All participants accepted into the CIT program will be required to get fingerprinted and must be cleared by the start of camp. Volunteer fingerprinting forms and instructions on the fingerprinting process will be given out upon acceptance into the program.

### CIT Program Cost

There is a weekly cost of \$40 for the CIT program. This cost goes towards the weekly field trip.

*Please note: Although working with children is a fun job, it must be taken seriously*

**Summer camp is 9 weeks long: June 13<sup>th</sup> – August 12<sup>th</sup>**

**We ask that you commit to at least 4 weeks of camp**
