Hillary Kaplowitz, 7th Degree Black Belt



Hillary Kaplowitz holds the nationally recognized rank of 6th degree black belt in Danzan Ryu Jujitsu and the title of Professor from the American Judo and Jujitsu Federation (AJJF). Prof. Kaplowitz began training as a youth and has been teaching Martial Arts since 2000, promoting 10 students to the rank of black belt and beyond.

Ralph Rosas, 3rd Degree Black Belt

Ralph Rosas trained with Prof Kaplowitz's for many years and now holds the nationally recognized rank of 3rd Degree Black Belt in Danzan Ryu Jujitsu. Sensei Rosas has been teaching alongside Prof Kaplowitz for over 15 years and has served the organization (AJJF) as Regional Black Belt Exam Coordinator.

Nathalie Chapple, 4th degree Black Belt

Nathalie has studied under Prof Kaplowitz for over 20 years. She holds the AJJF rank of Sandan-3rd degree Blackbelt. Sensei Nathalie had her own Danzan Ryu kids' dojo in Los Angeles for 5 years and continues to teach alongside Prof Kaplowitz and Sensei Rosas. She is serving on the AJJF Board of Directors and Chair of the Council of Senior Instructors.
