CITY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS **METRO REGION ADMINISTRATION** **GROUP LEADER CONTRACT**

- I. All members of your organization must cooperate fully with the terms of your granted permit, the office of issue: Metro Region Administration, the on-site Facility Recreation Director, and recreation staff on all matters related to your participation in any activity (i.e. designated areas to be used, control of participants, control and supervision of all areas of the facility, closing hours, etc.).
- II. Your organization must leave Park Facility free of trash, rubbish and debris. Your organization is responsible for any/all damages to park property and/or equipment caused by your organization's participation as a permittee.
- III. The possession or consumption of any/all alcoholic beverages, and/or controlled substances, by members of your organization (acting on your behalf as the permit holder), on the Park Facilities (fields, building, grounds, parking lot, etc.) is strictly prohibited. (County ordinance 10,309-Article II, Rules and Regulations, Sec. 48-49.)
- IV. All members of your organization must respect public and private property in or about the area of permit (i.e. loitering, curfew violations, blockage of driveways, noise abatement, littering, etc.).
- V. All members of your organization must use designated restrooms. Urinating in public is against the law.
- VI. All members (youth, coaches, managers, instructors, parents, spectators, officials) must wear face coverings at all times (including during play and heavy exertion, unless it may become a hazard) and maintain social distancing (except during play).
- VII. All members (players, coaches, managers, instructors, officials) must provide and use their own equipment. Equipment cannot be shared unless it is sanitized between each and every use.
- VIII. Approval of this permit is contingent upon the permittee's continued compliance with all federal, state and local regulations, orders, as well as the latest public health orders in effect as set forth by the Los Angeles Department of Public Health (LADPH) (collectively, Orders). Permittees associated with any youth and adult sports must comply with all of the requirements and conditions laid out in LADPH's *Reopening Protocol for Youth and Adult Recreational Sports Leagues*, including the requirement to obtain a completed and signed "Informed Consent Form" from each participant. This protocol provides direction on organized outdoor youth and recreational adult sports activities to reduce the risk of spread of COVID-19 during these sports. The requirements are specific to Youth and Adult Recreational Sports ("Recreational Sports") Programs permitted to be open by the Order of the State Public Health Officer. By applying for this permit, Permittees understand that it is their sole responsibility to comply with all the requirements set forth in the protocol and at no time will the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) be responsible for any part of their compliance. Upon request, Permittee shall provide to RAP a completed and signed Informed Consent Form for each of its participants. Failure to provide such forms or to maintain compliance with any Orders shall be cause for a previously approved permit to be revoked. Further, in accepting this permit, permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless RAP, along with its officers, agents, employees, or other representatives, and their successors and assigns, from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, rights, damages, expenses, and causes of action of whatever kind or nature, and other losses of any kind, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, as a result of permittee's failure to comply with any Orders. Failure to abide by any or all of the above provisions may, upon recommendation from the Metro Region Administration Section (permit granting agency), cause forfeiture of bond, and of future permitting privileges. Permits will only be issued while the County has an adjusted case rate equal to or less than 14 per 100,000. The City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks reserves the right to alter/update restrictions and protocols, and/or cancel permits, as the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health reopening protocols are undated and/or changed.

Failure to comply with provisions three (III) and (V) above is a misdemeanor and grounds for the immediate cancellation of permit, and/or termination of team from league participation. NO REFUNDS ISSUED FOR REVOKED PERMITS!
