REGISTRATION FEE & PAYMENT INFORMATION

- ◆ Registration fee includes: Jersey, award, and administrative costs.
- ◆ Register Online, Walk In, Scan QR Code
- ◆ Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration. Method of payments accepted: Cash (exact amount), checks, and credit cards (Visa or MasterCard).
- ◆ Please make checks payable to City of L.A. Department of Recreation and Parks.
- ◆ ***Individual and team pictures are not included in the registration fee.**
- ◆ Only siblings and children of the coaches will be placed on the same team.

EVALUATIONS (FIRST DAY)

- ◆ **All registered participants must attend the evaluations.**
- ◆ The purpose of the evaluations is to determine the skill level of each player and to balance the teams throughout the league. Participants are encouraged to wear shorts and basketball shoes. Each participant will perform several drills. Please see the other side of this page for evaluation dates and times.

PRACTICES & GAMES

- ◆ Teams will tentatively start practicing sometime in November for about one hour or two per week.
- ◆ Weekday practices will run between 5:30pm or 7:30pm. Saturdays, pre-season practices will take place between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.
- ◆ Practices may be modified at any time for the welfare of this league.
- ◆ Practice times and dates are not guaranteed due to limited gym availability.
- ◆ Games are projected to start Sat Jan 23rd, 2023. Each team will play at least eight (8) games. If enrollment is low, some divisions may need to be combined to a Co-Rec boys and girls league and they may need to travel to play other parks.

VOLUNTEER COACHES

- ◆ We are looking for volunteer coaches. If you are interested, and over 18 years of age, please contact the office (818) 343-5946 for more information.
- ◆ All coaches must be fully vaccinated, live-scanned and cleared by the Department of Recreation and Parks prior to coaching a team.

REFUND POLICY

- ◆ Full refunds will be issued only if the basketball league is cancelled by the recreation center.
- ◆ Refunds will be issued as credit towards your household registration account.
- ◆ If a refund is issued 15% will be deducted if participant withdraws for any reason.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- ◆ All participants, coaches and spectators are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. Make sure the game is fun for everyone involved. Meet the responsibilities to the coach and the team. Maintain an environment free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol. Make positive and encouraging comments. Keep emotions under control. Address problems, concerns or anything to the coach before approaching staff. Treat the public, officials and staff with respect. Avoid coaching and yelling out instructions from the sidelines. Those exhibiting poor sportsmanship, or unethical behavior may be asked to leave, suspended or removed from the league.
