Code of Conduct Guidelines



The safety, comfort, well-being and program experience for all participants is the number one priority for staff. The staff assigned to the After School Club program are all professionals who serve as positive role models when interacting with the participants. Good behavior and respect towards staff and fellow participants is expected from each participant. To maintain a safe and healthy environment, participants must abide by the code of conduct guidelines.

Participants are expected to conduct themselves in the following manner:

1. All youth must adhere to and follow all preventive measures to COVID-19 as instructed by staff at the beginning of each day (handwashing, social distancing, wear required face coverings, etc.).
2. Limit cell phone usage during program activity times. The facility is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
3. Be kind and respectful to fellow participants and staff. Foul language, screaming, loud noises, or interrupting others will not be tolerated.
4. Follow the directions of all recreation staff.
5. Possession of any kind of weapon or graffiti paraphernalia will be confiscated & returned to the parent or guardian.
6. Fighting or physical altercations will not be tolerated.

The After School Club Program staff with approval has the right to dismiss a participant from the program if the behavior becomes too disruptive, inhibits the ability for staff and/or children to adhere to preventive measures to COVID-19 as outlined in the registration materials and/or a participant is determined to be a danger to themselves or others.
