## THE FINE PRINT

- NO CAMP ON TRIP DAYS
- CAMPER MUST ATTEND CAMP 2 DAYS PRIOR TO TRIP TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE TRIP
- CAMPERS MUST BRING THEIR OWN NON-PERISHABLE LUNCH. SMALL AFTERNOON SNACK PROVIDED
- ON TRIP DAYS CAMPERS MUST WEAR THIS YEAR'S CAMP SHIRT
- ENROLLMENT REQUIRES SUBMISSION OF REGISTRATION FORM. LOOK FOR AN INVITE TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT WITH EPACT TO COMPLETE THE PARTICIPANT'S REGISTRATION INFORMATION
- FULL REFUNDS WILL ONLY BE GRANTED IF THE PROGRAM IS CANCELED BY THE CENTER. A 15% ADMINISTRATIVE FEE APPLIES TO ALL REFUND REQUEST
- REFUNDS REQUESTED WEEK OF CAMP WILL NOT BE GRANTED
- REQUEST FOR CARPOOL. SAME GROUP OR SPECIFIC COUNSELOR CANNOT BE GUARANTEED
- IF YOU ARE A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY AND REQUIRE ACCOMMODATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A CITY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS PROGRAM. SERVICE. OR ACTIVITY. REQUESTS MAY BE MADE BY CALLING THE FACILITY. 10 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF THE EVENT. WE WILL DO OUR BEST TO FULFILL REQUESTS WITH LESS THAN 10 BUSINESS DAY'S NOTICE
- IF A PARTICIPANT REQUIRES A ONE TO ONE AIDE. REQUESTS WILL BE FULFILLED WITHIN 7 BUSINESS DAYS OF RECEIVING REQUIRED PAPERWORK AND DOCUMENTATION NEEDED TO ISSUE A RIGHT OF ENTRY PERMIT TO THE AGENCY PROVIDING THE AIDE.
- PROGRAMS AND CLASSES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE OR CANCELLATION WITHOUT NOTICE

## CAMP RULES & GUIDELINES

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE MEANT TO BE DISCUSSED AND UNDERSTOOD BY BOTH PARENTS AND PARTICIPANTS.

- PARTICIPANTS ARE EXPECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL ACTIVITIES AND FOLLOW DIRECTIONS AT ALL TIMES
- SAFETY RATIOS OF 1 STAFF PER 10 CHILDREN.
- SANDALS OR OPEN TOE SHOES SHOULD NOT BE WORN TO PROGRAM.
- CLOTHING SHOULD BE MODEST, PRACTICAL, AND SUITABLE FOR OUTDOOR PLAY, GROUP ACTIVITIES, AND ACTIVE MOVEMENT.
- ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SHOW RESPECT FOR THEMSELVES, OTHER PARTICIPANTS AND THE PROGRAM STAFF.
- PARTICIPANTS MUST TAKE A BUDDY WITH THEM AND NOTIFY STAFF WHEN THEY GO TO THE RESTROOM AND/OR TO GET A DRINK OF WATER.
- PARTICIPANTS MUST LET A COUNSELOR KNOW WHERE THEY ARE GOING AT ALL TIMES.
- CHILDREN MUST NOT HARM ANYONE. NO FIGHTING, PUSHING, SHOVING, OR THROWING DEBRIS OR OBJECTS. CHILDREN MUST NOT USE PROFANITY.
- PARTICIPANTS ARE EXPECTED TO HANDLE YOSEMITE EQUIPMENT, GAMES, MATERIAL AND SUPPLIES APPROPRIATELY.
- REPEATED REMINDERS OF INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR, VIOLENT BEHAVIORS, BULLYING, DISCRIMINATION OR BEHAVIOR THAT CREATES A SAFETY CONCERN WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE PROGRAM.
- PLEASE REFER TO DAY CAMP MANUAL FOR MORE DETAILED PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.
