# 2025 CITYWIDE YOUTH BASEBALL & SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

#### **TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

- 1. All citywide youth baseball and girls' softball rules shall apply.
- 2. All participants must sign-in prior to playing in the game.
- 3. Teams listed in the left side of the bracket will occupy the 1st base dugout and will be the home team.
- 4. No infield practice or warm-up is allowed.
- 5. RULES PROTEST PROCEDURES: Protests will only be accepted concerning a misinterpretation of the rules. Coaches must notify the umpire prior to the next pitch, if there is a protest. The game will be stopped at that point and the committee will be called to make the final decision. The committee's decision shall be final. Protest time is part of game time. Protests will not be heard on umpire's judgment calls.
- 6. Games will start on time. There is no grace period. It is up to each team to allow proper travel time to get to each game venue on time.
  - NOTE: A team may start the game with 8 players, but, in order to avoid a forfeit, the 9th player must arrive before the first pitch of the third inning.
- 7. Teams should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to game time in order to sign-in.
- 8. If the game remains tied, an extra inning will be played. If the game still remains tied after that inning, all subsequent innings shall begin with a base runner on 2nd base. The runner will be the player scheduled to bat last in that respective inning.
  - Exception: The citywide final will be played to a full six (6) or seven (7) innings, or until the point a 10-run mercy rule is reached.
- The space behind each backstop will be sectioned off and reserved for Sports Board members and RAP staff only.
- 10. Recording devices attached to the fence will not be allowed.

#### <u>CITYWIDE YOUTH SPORTS SPORTSMANSHIP STATEMENT</u>

Good sportsmanship among spectators, parents, coaches, players, and officials is expected.

We require that **ALL** spectators practice supportive and encouraging behavior at all times.

Inappropriate conduct and/or negative gestures are not allowed during any part of the game.

Examples of such behavior include the following:

- Taunting the opposing team and their supporters
- Derogatory comments to the officials/referees
- Distracting players with stomping, yelling, and/or banging devices
- Usage of loudsounds and artificial noisemakers, such as horns, whistles, and bells are prohibited

Failure to comply with the above rules may officially end the game and result in a forfeit loss for the offending team.






